Your child must be 18 months by October first to participate. Classes will begin Tuesday, Oct. 5 and run for 14 weeks ending the last week of January 2010.

The purpose of Circle of Two is for toddlers to experience social interactions in a safe and nurturing environment while giving parents an opportunity to enjoy their child in a classroom setting. Each week, parent and child will explore a project together, enjoy hearing a story with new friends, come together to share a snack and, of course, discover how wonderful we are as we play with our peers. Parents will have the opportunity to support each other and to learn what makes the nearly 2-year-old so special.

The cost for once a week is \$425 and for both sessions a week the fee is \$799 for the 14 weeks.
